Description of visuals of the TV Announcement in the Public Interest	
Description of visuals:	The screen shows a speech bubble containing the words “A Clear Basis for Achieving Universal Suffrage”. The Secretary for Justice, Mr Rimsky Yuen, appears. He speaks in front of the camera:
Secretary for Justice Mr Rimsky Yuen:	The selection of the Chief Executive by universal suffrage in 2017 will be a milestone in Hong Kong’s constitutional development. The Basic Law sets out the aim of achieving universal suffrage and the relevant principles. On this basis, we can elect our Chief Executive by “one person, one vote”
Description of visuals:	Two speech bubbles containing the words “Universal suffrage” and “one person, one vote” appear beside him. Mr Yuen continues:
Secretary for Justice Mr Rimsky Yuen:	So, what does the Basic Law say? Let’s take a look!

Male narrator:	According to Article 45 of the Basic Law, the selection of the Chief Executive consists of three steps.

Male narrator:	to nominate candidates in accordance with democratic procedures.
Description of visuals:	A speech bubble containing the words “Nominate Candidates” appears above the “Nominating Committee” word block.

Male narrator:	Second, “one-person, one-vote” election. All eligible Hong Kong voters will elect the Chief Executive through “one-person, one vote”.

Description of visuals:	The screen shows the straight road again. There is a speech bubble containing the word “Appointment” on the road. The male narrator says:
Male narrator:	Third, appointment.
Description of visuals:	The figure representing the Chief Executive-elect stands in front of the national flag of the People’s Republic of

	China and the regional flag of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region, holding an Order of the State Council. A word block “Chief Executive” appears in front of the figure. The male narrator says:
The male narrator:	Appointment by the Central People’s Government as the Chief Executive.
Description of visuals:	The screen shows the straight road again. There are three speech bubbles containing the words “Nomination”, “One person, one vote” and “appointment” on the road. Mr Yuen appears again with a word block “Chief Executive Election in 2017” at his side. Mr Yuen says:
SJ Rinsky Yuen:	Following these steps, we can all elect our Chief Executive in 2017!
Description of visuals:	The TV Announcement in the Public Interest ends.
